

How to get your visa to study in Germany

General requirements

Please check the website of the respective German embassy or consulate for requirements in your country as these might vary.

You already submitted to and received from UE the following documents which you now need for your visa application. These are:

- Certificates of academic qualification and academic records or transcript
- CV
- Motivational letter stating the reason for choosing the specific university and study program.
- UE letter of admission and the other admission documents you have received from UE
- proof of English language proficiency

In addition you should prepare and submit:

- two duly completed national visa application forms
- valid passport
- 2 [biometric](#) passport photos
- blocked account

A blocked account is an account for international students that must have funds of €10,332 (living costs for 1 year) and permits the withdrawal of a certain amount per month: €861. Current providers of blocked accounts are: BAM, Coracle, Deutsche Bank, Expatrio, Fintiba

- proof of [health insurance](#) in Germany. It must have coverage of at least 30,000 EUR and it must be valid for at least 3 months. For example you could check this [consulting tool](#) to find out what insurance is the right one for you.

These documents have to be submitted as originals, usually accompanied by two photocopies each.
