Why the UE?

Due to the development of digital media, the working methods, requirements, technical workflows and application spectra are constantly changing. Nevertheless, the art of drawing as a craft foundation and as an elementary cultural technique for communication and idea generation is indispensable. Studying illustration at the University of Europe for Applied Sciences (UE) combines the classical arts such as painting, drawing and printmaking with the fascination of contemporary design through modern and digital techniques.

The bachelor's programme has been a regular part of the study programme since 2012. Before 2017, it was run by the former Berlin Technical University of the Arts (BTK), which was then renamed to UE. During this programme you can choose from a wide range of interdisciplinary subjects, meaning you determine the content of your studies and the direction you take.

As an illustration student you will tell stories, illustrate books, comics and storyboards from which entire films are created. Your potential career fields are wide-ranging. Children's book illustrations, infographics and editorial illustrations in magazines or advertising campaigns. Scientific illustration and graphic recording are professional fields for illustrators as well as the conceptual creation of Computer Games.
